# Shared Test Categories

**Shared Classroom Assessment:** can recommend to teachers or schools, not able to compare class data

**School Assessment:** can recommend to teachers or schools, can compare class data


**Benchmark Assessment:** can recommend to teachers or schools, can compare class data, data is part of KPI

Users must have appropriate permissions to create these different types of tests. Test category can be changed by making a copy of existing test.


